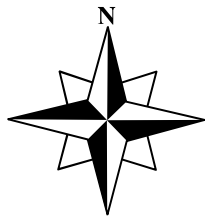

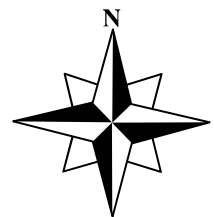

### Alcohol and Drug Abuse Community Coalition-Building Prevention Program

*COMPASS is a science-based research approach which builds on the belief that community coalitions can prevent alcohol and drug dependency as well as reduce youth crime rates. This can be accomplished by early identification of individual, family, school and community risk factors. By building a web of protective, science-based prevention strategies and services, change can take place.*

*This prevention approach has received the following awards:*

*In 1998, received a New York State OASAS Local Incentive Grant to implement the risk and protection model within a comprehensive school/community structure in the Bay Shore/Brightwaters School District. **This grant was renewed in 1999, 2000 and 2001.***

*In 2000, received a Drug-Free Communities Support Program Grant from the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention. Suffolk Coalition was one of four grants awarded in New York State and the only Long Island agency to receive an award. The grant will support the growth of the OASAS Local Incentive Grant in Bay Shore/Brightwaters. **This grant was renewed in 2001, 2002, 2003 and 2004.***

*In 2001, received a Drug-Free Communities Support Program Grant from the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention. It was one of 157 grants awarded nationally and the only award on Long Island. This grant will support the work and growth of COMPASS in the Southampton School District. **This grant was renewed in 2002, 2003 and 2004.***

*In 2002, received a Drug-Free Communities Support Program Grant from the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention. It was one of 70 grants awarded nationally and the only award on Long Island. This grant will begin the work of COMPASS in the West Islip School District. **This grant was renewed in 2003 and 2004.***

*In 2003, received a Bureau of Justice Assistance Congressionally Mandated Award. This grant will fund the COMPASS Coalition Training Academy of Long Island. This first coalition training academy on Long Island will serve as a model in New York State.*

*In 2003, received a Drug-Free Communities Support Program Grant from the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention for Coalition Mentoring. This COMPASS coalition mentoring will take place in the Amityville and Riverhead school districts. This grant was one of 20 awarded in the country and the only one awarded in New York State. **This grant was renewed in 2004.***
